# Ane Katrine Hansdatter Jensen Wulff b. 18 Jan 1837

After the death of Jens Jensen, his widow Ane Katrine married a man named Hans Wulff (sometimes spelled "Wolff"). Found in the records of the Magleby Church is the marriage of Hans Christiansen Friederik Wulff to the 1<sup>st</sup> time widow, Ane Katrine Hansdatter. This wedding occurred on December 28, 1877 in the Magleby Church. This record indicates that Hans was born in Kiel, Germany on February 27, 1840 and was currently 37 years old. It indicates that Ane was born on January 18, 1837 and was currently 40 years old. It also indicates that she was marrying Hans after the death of her husband Jens Jensen Kallehave.

Hans and Ane Katrine had one daughter named Jensine (often went by "Sina").

Hans and Ane Katrine immigrated to the United States in 1907, and they eventually ended up in Fremont, Nebraska. According to the Danish Emigration Database, the 70-year old Ane Katrine and the 65-year old Hans Wolff immigrated on board the ship "United States". Their destination was given as New York. The registration date was given as April 4, 1907. These records indicate that Ane Katrine was born in Ugledie, Allerslev Parish, Præstø County, Denmark. Hans Wolff was born in Slesvig. Slesvig is a Danish way of writing "Schleswig" which is an historical town in the northeastern part of Schleswig-Holstein, Germany. Hans's last residence was also given as Ugledie, Allerslev Parish, Præstø County, Denmark.

1910 Census (*Here mentioned Carl, son = Carla daughter*)

In 1910, the 70-year old Hans Wolff and the 73-year old "Kate" (abbreviated form for Ane Katrine) have been found living 940 West 8<sup>th</sup> St. in Fremont, Dodge County, Nebraska at the time of the 1910 Federal Census. They were living with their daughter Jensine and husband Hans Ludwigsen. Hans and Ane Katrine had been married for 32 years at this time which would put their marriage at ca. 1878. It indicates that Ane Katrine was the mother of 4 children of which 4 were still living. Interestingly, it indicates that this was the first marriage for Hans Wolff but the third marriage for Ane. So we have another marriage to look for? (or this could be a mistake) This census record confirms that Hans was born in Germany and Ane Katrine in Denmark. Neither Hans nor Ane Katrine were employed at this time.

In 1917, Hans Wolff died.

Hans C. F. Wulff Fremont Herald; 26 April 1918, p. 8.

Hans Wulff died suddenly at the home of his daughter, Mrs. H. P. Ludvigsen, Wednesday morning. He was at the breakfast table when the call came. He had not been very ill and not the slightest intimation that his end was so near had been manifested. Mr. Wulff was a native of Denmark, born at what is now called Kiel, Germany. He was a veteran of the war of 1864, the outcome of which resulted in Germany seizing possession of Danish territory. Another daughter of Mr. Wulff is Mrs. C. H. Christiansen, who with the widow and a sister residing in Chicago, are the immediate surviving relatives. The funeral will take place Sunday at 2:30 p.m. from the Danish Lutheran church.

Ane Katrine "Kate" Wolff died in Fremont on June 5, 1923 and was buried in the Ridge Cemetery in Fremont.

# FREMONT WOMEN MOURN DEATH OF AGED MOTHER

Mesdames, C. H. Christensen and H. P. Ludvigsen and their families mourn the death of their aged mother, Mrs. Anne Kathrine Wulf, who passed away at three o'clock Tuesday morning, at the Ludvigsen home, 908 North I street, from ailments due to her burden of eighty-six years of age.

The deceased woman was a native of Denmark, born January 18, 1837. It is but sixteen years ago that she, with her husband, the late Hans Wulf, came to America and settled in this city. Mr. Wulf passed away five years ago, since which time the window has resided with her daughter, Mrs. Ludvigsen. Surviving Mrs. Wulf are three daughters and a son: Mrs. C. H. Christensen and Mrs. H. P. Ludvigsen, Fremont; Mrs. L. C. Fries and J. P. Jensen of Chicago.

The Rev. James C. Petersen, pastor of the Danish Lutheran church, of which the deceased was a member, will officiate at the funeral services today, to be held from the Ludvigsen home at 1:30 o'clock this afternoon and from the church at two o'clock. Interment will be made in Ridge cemetery. --Fremont Herald; 08 June 1923; p. 7.





The 25 year old Hans Ludwigsen has been found living with the 31 year old wife Jensine in Fremont, Dodge County, Nebraska at the time of the 1910 Federal Census. Hans's occupation was a "shoemaker" and he owned his own shop. This was the first marriage for both Hans and Jensine and they had been married for 5 years. Jensine was listed as the mother of 3 children, but only 2 were still alive as of that date. Also living with them was the 3 year old daughter Carla (born in Denmark) and the 1½ year old daughter Olga (born in Nebraska). This census record also gives the family address as 940 W. 8<sup>th</sup> St. Also living here with them at the time was Jensine's parents, Hans and Ane Katrine Wolff.





Hans Peter Ludvigsen registered for the World War I draft on September 12, 1918. This record indicates that Hans was born in April 25, 1884. He was living at 940 W. 8<sup>th</sup> St. in Fremont, Dodge County, Nebraska. His occupation was "shoemaker". His business place was at 622 N. Main St. He was a naturalized U.S. citizen by this time. He was of medium height and stout build. He had blue eyes and light hair. His wife's name was given as Mrs. Jensine Ludvigsen.


1920 census

### Mrs. Ludvigsen Dies in Fremont

Mrs. Hans P. Ludvigsen, 70, died Monday after an illness for which she had been hospitalized 13 days. Born Nov. 31, 1878, at Magleby, Denmark, Mrs. Ludvigsen came with her husband to Fremont in 1907. They had been married in Allerslev, Denmark, on July 27, 1905. Mrs. Ludvigsen was a member of the Danish sisterhood lodge of Fremont.

Survivors include the widower, three daughters, Mrs. Carla Kreller and Mrs. Olga Wallace of Fremont and Mrs. Mabel Sevy of Grand Island; and a son, Elmer of Fremont. A son and a sister preceded her in death.

Funeral services are to be at 2:30 p.m. Thursday in the chapel of the Lawson Funeral home with Rev. Adolph Kloth of First Lutheran church officiating. Mrs. Ludvigsen will lie in state at the home of her son, Elmer, who lives on Old Military road, from 5 p.m., Wednesday until the time of the service.

Burial is to be in Ridge cemetery. The Ludvigsen Shoe Repair shop will remain closed all day Thursday because of funeral services for Mrs. H. P. Ludvigsen.

Hans P. Ludvigsen Dies Here Friday

Funeral services for Hans P. Ludvigsen, 67, have been set for Monday at 2 p.m. at the First Lutheran church with Rev. A. L. Madsen officiating.

Burial will be in the family lot at Ridge cemetery. Bendorf Funeral home at Blair is in charge of arrangements.

Survivors include one son, Elmer Ludvigsen of Fremont; three daughters, Mrs. Carla Kreller, Mrs. Alga Wallace of Fremont and Mrs. Mabel Sevy of Bellevue; and six grandchildren. His wife and one son preceded him in death.

Born on Apr. 25, 1884 at Magleby, Denmark, Mr. Ludvigsen was married to Jensine Wolff on July 25, 1905 before coming to this country two years later.

He made his home in Fremont and opened a shoe repair shop in 1909 on Main Street between Sixth and Seventh. In 1925 he returned to Denmark for a visit with his family.

He died Friday evening at local hospital following an illness of more than fie years.

The body will lie in state at the home of the son, Elmer Ludvigsen on Old Military road, RFD 3 from 2 p.m. Sunday until service time on Monday.
